How did the Fund perform last year and what affected its performance?

Although the Fund is not managed relative to any securities market index or benchmark, a discussion of the Fund's performance relative to the Tokyo Stock Price Index (TR) ("TOPIX") is included for comparative purposes.

Class VI shares of GMO-Usonian Japan Value Creation Fund returned +6.41% (net) for the fiscal year ended February 28, 2025, as compared with +1.53% for TOPIX.


In 2024, Japan's equity market experienced significant growth, with the TOPIX index rising by 20.02% for the calendar year in local terms, due to solid global economic growth and stock market reforms. The end of deflation and renewed corporate dynamism further boosted investor confidence.

Relative to the TOPIX, our security selection contributed to returns in the fiscal year. Security selection in Industrials and Financials contributed to the returns, while overweight in Information Technology and underweight in Communication Services detracted.

The fee reimbursements will continue until at least June 30, 2025 and may not be terminated prior to this date without the action or consent of the Trust's Board of Trustees. Elimination of this reimbursement will result in higher fees and lower performance.
